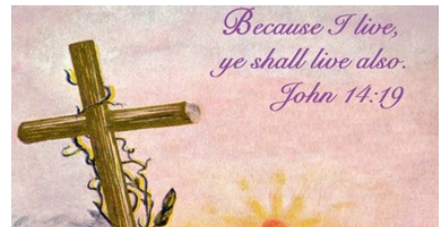
### Staff news...
